Training for work in Australia

Certificate II in Community Services provides a pathway into Certificate III in aged care, children's services, disability, home and community care.

MRC Works provides class based training with specialised on the job coaching for you to reach your employment goal.

Assessment

Work based assessments are done in training sessions or on work experience placements. You receive a full Certificate or a Statement of Attainment for completed units.

Eligibility and Enrolment

There is a Pre entry Language Assessment before enrolment. ACSF level 2 or above is needed to do the Certificate II in Community Services or to apply for RPL.

Credit Transfer or RPL

You may be able to get credit for Certificate 11 units completed in Australia. Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for work and training you have done overseas or in Australia is also available.

If you are interested make an appointment to see the MRC Works Training Manager. We will need you to show an Academic transcript from an accredited VET institution showing the units and the grades you received within the last 5 years. For RPL there will be a formal interview.
